Grades serviced: 6TH, 7TH AND 8TH grade students
Program staff: Ms. Jill Amico, Ms. Sarah Gilbert, Mr. Curt Crowl and Mrs. Amy Kline
(Volunteers from Avondale High School National Junior Honor Society also help out)

Eligibility and Placement Criteria: All criteria considered is referenced on a 4-point scale aligning with the MEAP 4-point proficiency rubric. All data points are combined to create one eligibility score, and all students are placed in rank order. Students are placed into interventions based on highest need in relation to their eligibility score. Individual subject area data points are reviewed to determine necessary interventions.

Sixth Grade:

- Leveled Literacy Initiative exit running records scores (from 5th grade)
- Fifth grade MEAP Assessment (only non-proficient student data is included)
- Academic grades (first and second trimester grades in four core subject areas)

Seventh/Eighth Grade:

- Sixth/Seventh grade MEAP Assessment (only non-proficient student data is included)
- Academic grades (first and second semester grades in four core subject areas)

Learning Objective: Students will decrease the amount of missing work, improve their test scores and overall grades.

Program Strategies: The Homework Club sponsors will ...

- Monitor weekly performance on MI-Star and assist students with current homework as well as missing work that is due.
- Design and implement individualized programing on Pearson SuccessMaker and/or Study Island for students who have finished all of their work on a given day.
- Provide weekly progress reports of grades/progress to students and parents.

Homework Club is offered to students in grades 6, 7 and 8 and is staffed by Ms. Jill Amico, counselor, Ms. Sarah Gilbert, classroom teacher, paraprofessionals Curt Crowl and Amy Kline and volunteers from Avondale High School National Junior Honor Society also help out. Homework Club meets twice per week after school for approximately 1.5 hours and transportation is provided home. **Measurement of Success**

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
